The suitable person will provide support to the school-based curriculum development of a three-year Quality Education Fund project. Duties include: (a) providing on-site school-based professional support service to schools in respect of school-based curriculum development in Music; (b) catering for learner diversity as appropriate; (c) enhancing student learning through giving advices on effective learning method, teaching and assessment strategies and curriculum resources.

Interested persons should possess (a) a Bachelor's degree; (b) a certificate in education from tertiary educational institution in Hong Kong, or equivalent; (c) sound music training background with proven qualification; and (d) at least 5 years of relevant post-qualification experience in teaching or curriculum development or advisory service in mainstream schools and/or special schools. Preference will be given to candidates who possess a higher degree or above in music education and/or special education or related discipline, or possess relevant professional qualification.

The most suitable person will be invited to enter into a contract for service which is not intended as a staff appointment at the Hong Kong Baptist University, and hence it should not be construed as implying an employer-employee relationship between the candidate and the University.
